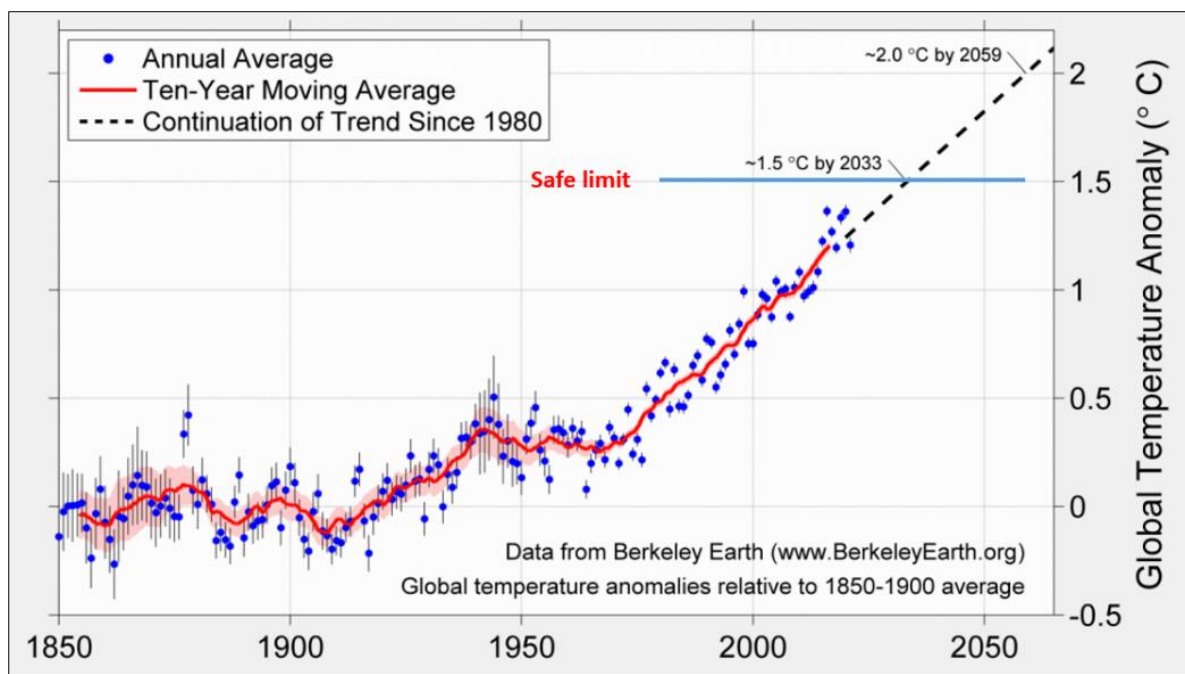




Zero Carbon Week 22nd – 26th September 2025

But, **time is running out**. The 1.5°C safe limit will be reached soon

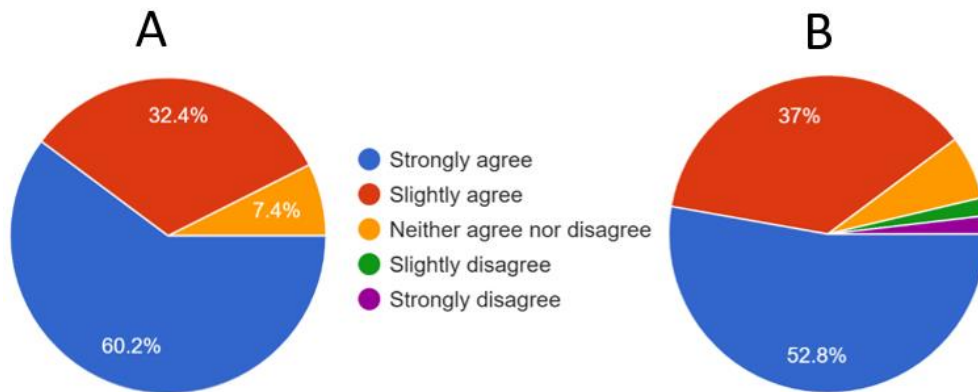


In 2021 our Parish Council and Civic Society came together with other village communities to create
